TWO WAYS YOU CAN HELP:



1. Volunteer for a day to help construct the new Friends Center, an exciting project that combines environmentalism, peace activism and social justice organizing. The Friends Center is a collaborative project between the Peace Resource Center, Church of the Brethren, San Diego Friends Meeting (Quakers) and American Friends Service Committee. The environmentally friendly, energy-efficient building will house the PRC, Friends Meeting and AFSC U.S.-Mexico Border Project and also provide meeting space for other community organizations and projects. Join us in preparing the ground for concrete that will be poured for the foundation of the Peace Center's offices. Also, we'll be weeding the permaculture project that we installed at last year's Work-a-thon.

2. Sponsor a volunteer worker. Your donation as a sponsor will give encouragement to those donating their labor and also benefit two peace groups: the Project on Youth and Non-Military Opportunities (Project YANO) and the Peace Resource Center of San Diego (see below).

WORK-A-THON VOLUNTEERS – On June 4, volunteers will spend the day leveling ground and installing foam insulation, rebar and tubing, and clearing weeds on the slope of the new building pad. Labor will include spreading sand, tying steel rebar, laying down visquine, and pulling weeds. All tasks are outdoors, in full sun, though there will be shady rest areas. Workers are asked to solicit sponsorships from family members, friends, employers, etc., to match their contribution of labor with a donation. To volunteer as a worker, please complete and return the bottom coupon now and an information packet will be sent to you. You should begin collecting sponsorships right away using the form on the back of this flier to record sponsors' names and contributions/pledges.

WORK-A-THON SPONSORS – Sponsors contribute money in support of a volunteer worker.
